As so much in our beautiful world of IT it's very easy:

- 1. Open your php.ini in the editor of your trust.
- 2. Find this line:
 - ; Decides whether PHP may expose the fact that it is installed on the server
 - ; (e.g. by adding its signature to the Web server header). It is no security
 - ; threat in any way, but it makes it possible to determine whether you use PHP
 - ; on your server or not.
 - $expose_php = On$
- 3. Change the On to an Off.

```
expose_php = Off
```

4. Reload your Apache and the X-Powered-By: PHP header is gone.
